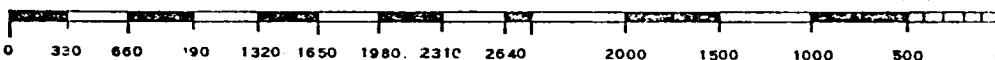
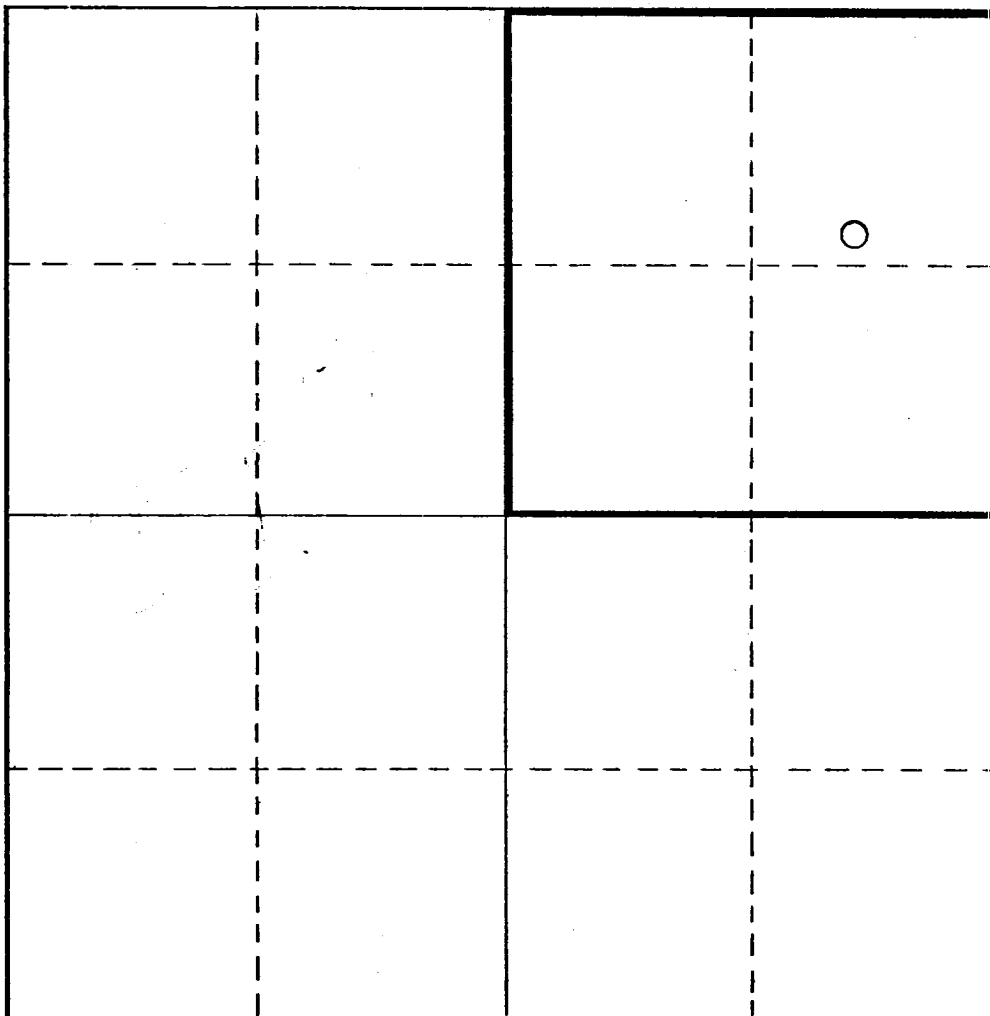

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on March 5, 1986, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 14th day of March, 1986, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) - Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) There is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Organ Rock formation, said pool to bear the designation of Big Gap-Organ Rock Pool. Said Big Gap-Organ Rock Pool was discovered by the Petroleum Energy, Inc. Navajo Tribal AS Well No. 1, located in Unit M of Section 28, Township 27 North, Range 19 West, NMPM. It was completed in the Organ Rock formation on August 11, 1965. The top of the perforations is at 3,550 feet.

(3) There is need for the contraction of the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and the deleted acreage is to be included in the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool.
