DETAILS OF WORK

Refer to supplementary well history dated 11-30-62. T.D. 950' in Dakota formation. Perforated first Dakota from 859'-865' and 869'-879'. Sand-fraced with 4,000# sand and 5,000 gallons Dakota crude. Recovered 26 bbls. load oil, 98 bbls. load oil not recovered. Perforated second Dakota from 923'-902'. No commercial production encountered in either Dakota bench; therefore, it is proposed to plug and abandon the subject well as follows:

(PBD)-923' to 700' - with 30 sacks regular cement
80' to surface - with 10 sacks regular cement.

A surface monument will be erected in accordance with regulations, and the location will be cleaned.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
