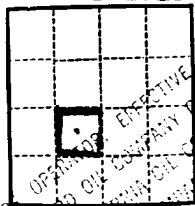

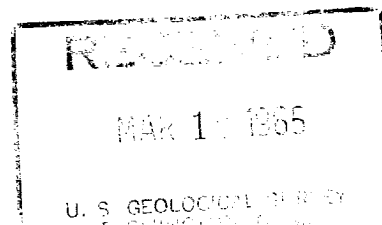
DETAILS OF WORK
