Dear Mr. Moya:

We have as of this date received your Notice of Intention to Drill your John J. Moya #1 Hubbard-Moya in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 4-30N-11W. We have talked to the Pierce agency regarding the location correction on your bond and they are having the bonding company send a rider to Santa Fe correcting the location from the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$. When we have received this we will approve the Notice of Intention to Drill and send you a copy. On your Notice of Intention to Drill you have neglected to indicate whether or not Lloyd Hubbard is the fee owner of the entire 160 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4-30N-11W. Will you please write us a letter indicating if Lloyd Hubbard owns the whole 160 acres, and if not who the other patented landowners are or what the land status is.

If you are ready to commence drilling operations you may consider this your authority to do so.
