ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on July 14, 1971,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 19th day of July, 1971, the Commission, a
quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the
record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being
fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the
subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Rijan Oil Company, Inc., seeks
authority to institute a pressure maintenance project in the
Slick Rock-Dakota Pool on its Rijan Wells Nos. 10, 12, and 14
located, respectively, in Units F, L, and K of Section 31,
Township 30 North, Range 16 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New
Mexico, by injection of water into the Dakota formation.

(3) That the proposed pressure maintenance project is in
the interest of conservation and should result in greater ulti-
mate recovery of oil, thereby preventing waste.

(4) That the subject application should be approved and the
project should be governed by the provisions of Rules 701, 702,
and 703 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Rijan Oil Company, Inc., is hereby authorized to institute a pressure maintenance project in the Slick Rock-Dakota Pool by the injection of produced water into the Dakota formation through its Rijan Wells Nos. 10, 12, and 14, located, respectively, in Units F, L, and K of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

(2) That the subject pressure maintenance project is hereby designated the Rijan Slick Rock Pressure Maintenance Project and shall be governed by the provisions of Rules 701, 702, and 703 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

(3) That monthly progress reports of the pressure maintenance project herein authorized shall be submitted to the Commission in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

(4) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
