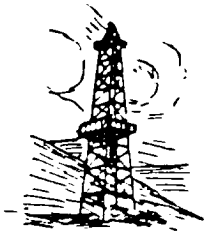

Reference is made to your letter of July 8, 1981 concerning the captioned wells.




My field personnel advised on July 30th that a vacuum truck had been utilized to vacuum what approximately was one barrel of oil from the pit of the #1 Apperson well. I have no further communication that this was done, but have no reason to think that this work has not been accomplished in view of my pumper's report.

With regard to the salt water disposal well on the Kaempff lease, you are advised that this disposal well was never utilized. When we tried to set 2 7/8" tubing in the well to be used as casing, the company that was retained to do the cementing allowed cement to plug off a portion of the casing, and to add to the problem, a packer was lost in the hole as well. Thus the well was effectively plugged and hence abandoned. Thus we were never able to use the well as a disposal well. This happened in July, 1974.
