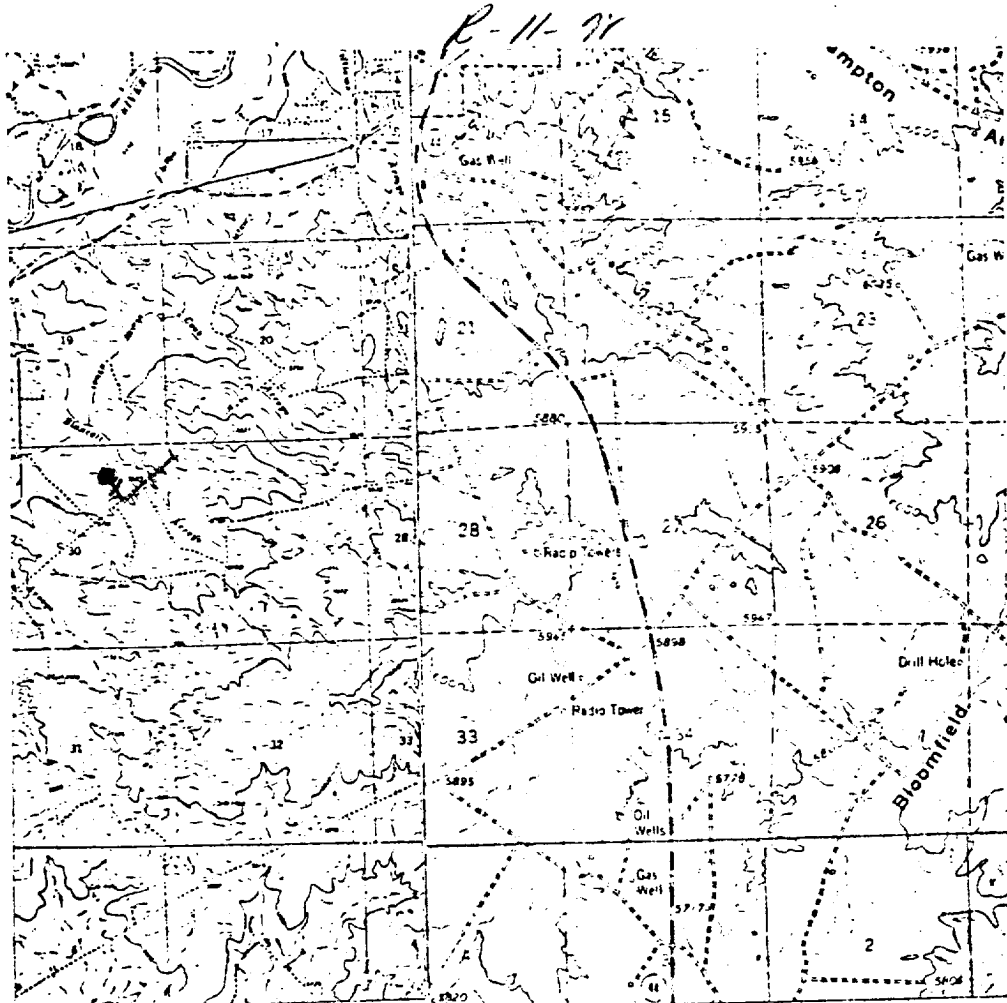
LOCATION AND EQUIPMENT LAY-OUT

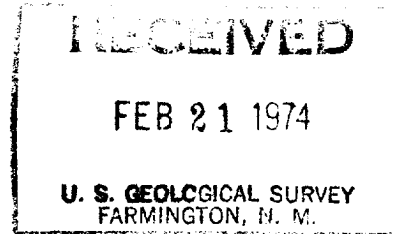

The proposed new well location, new roads and new pipeline are shown on the attached plat along with connecting existing roads and pipelines in the vicinity of the proposed new well.

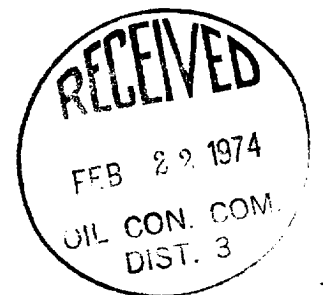
Water for drilling and completion operations will be obtained from the following location: San Juan River located South of Bloomfield, Section 27, T-29-N, R-11-W
