Water for drilling and completion operations will be obtained from the following location: Knickerbocker Butte Water Well #1, NESE 23-30-10.

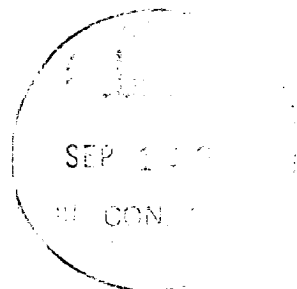

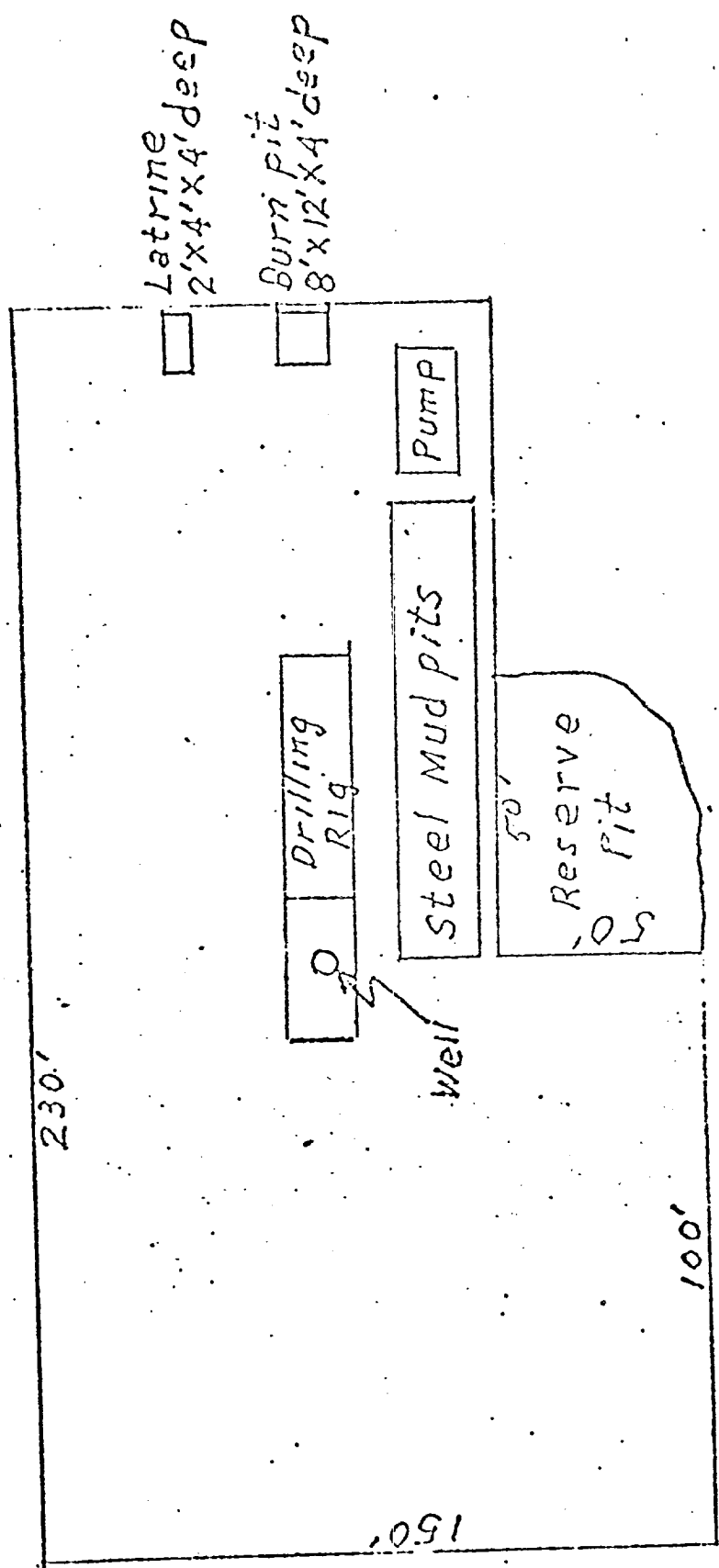

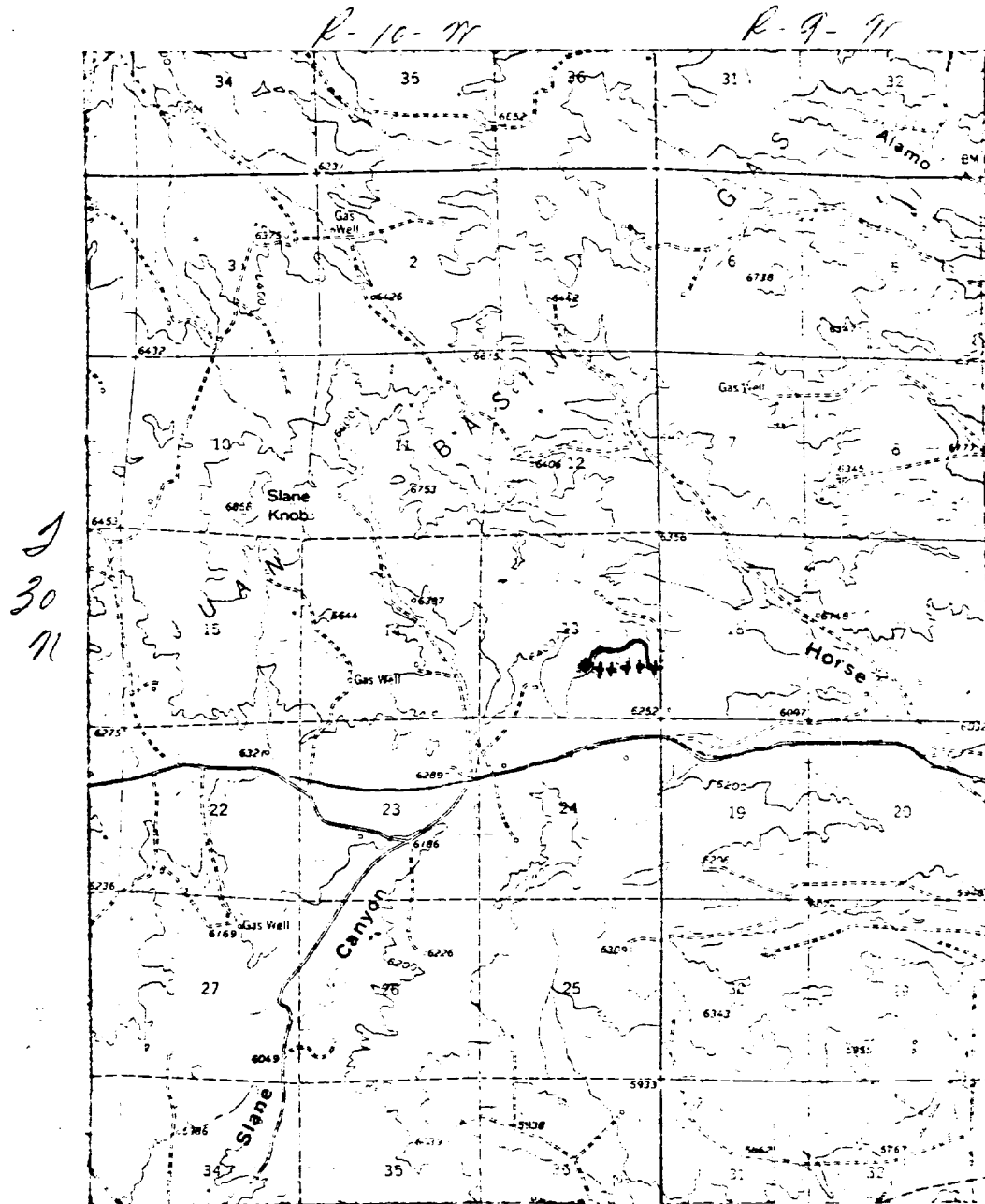
LOCATION AND EQUIPMENT LAY-OUT


