1. Drilled 8-3/4" hole, with mud, to T.D. of 3530 ft. R.K.B.
2. Ran IBS log.
3. Ran 87 jts. of 7", 23.0#, Intermediate casing. Landed at 3530 ft. Cemented casing w/251 sacks of cement.
4. Drilled 6-1/4" hole to T.D. of 5810 ft. R.K.B. Reached T.D. 7/5/75.
5. Ran Density log.
6. Ran 74 jts. of 4-1/2", 10.5# casing as liner. Top of liner at 3372 ft. Bottom of liner at 5810 ft. R.K.B. Cemented liner w/300 sacks.
7. Moved in and rigged up completion unit on 8/22/75.
8. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and bit. Cleaned out to P.B.T.D. of 5767 ft. RKB.
9. Pressure tested casing to 2700 psi. Test OK.
10. Ran Cement Bond and Correlation logs.
11. Perforated Point Lookout 1 shot/ft. from 5655-5667 ft., 5532-5580 ft. Total of 48 holes.
12. Sand Water fraced perforations using 60,000# sand and 60,000 gallons water.
13. Set HDWOO 4-1/2" Bridge Plug at 5270 ft.
14. Perforated Cliff House zone 1 shot/ft. from 5154 - 5214 ft. Total of 60 holes.
15. Sand Water fraced perforations using 59,000# sand and 59,000 gallons of water.
16. Picked up 2-3/8" tubing and bit. Drilled out bridge plug at 5270 ft. Cleaned out to P.B.T.D.
17. Ran 173 jts. fo 2-1/16", 3.25#, I.J. production tubing & landed at 5610 ft. R.K.B.
18. Well completed 8/29/75.

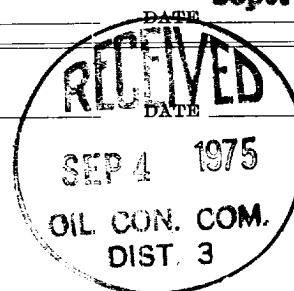

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
