1. Drilled 9-7/8" hole with mud to 3040 ft. R.K.B.

2. Ran IES log.

3. Ran 92 jts. of 7", 23.0# intermediate casing. Landed at 3039 ft. R.K.B. Stage collar set at 1996 ft. R.K.B. Cemented 1st stage w/200 sacks cement. Cemented 2nd stage with 237 sacks cement. Cement circulated on both stages.

4. Drilled 6-1/4" hole with gas to T.D. of 5320 ft. R.K.B. Reached T.D. 5/5/75.

5. Ran Density and Temperature logs.

6. Ran 73 jts. of 4-1/2", 10.5# casing as liner. Top of liner at 2890 ft. R.K.B. Bottom of liner at 5318 ft. R.K.B. Cemented liner w/370 sacks cement. Plug down at 4:00 P.M. 5-6-75.

7. Moved in and rigged up Completion Unit on 6/2/75.

8. Pressure tested casing to 2500 psi. Test OK.

9. Perforated Point Lookout 1 shot/ft. 5068 - 5092, 5107-5113, & 5163-5178 ft. Total of 45 holes.

10. Sand Water frac perfs with 60,000# sand and 63,000 gallons water.

11. Set 7" Baker "P-1" Bridge Plug at 4770 ft. R.K.B.

12. Perforated Cliff House 1 shot/ft. from 4656 to 4711 ft. Total of 15 holes.

13. Sand Water frac perfs w/27,000# sand and 30,000 gallons of water.

14. Ran 2-1/8" tubing and bit. Drilled out bridge plug at 4770 ft. Cleaned out to P.B.T.D. of 5261 ft. R.K.B.
