Reference is made to your request for an exception to the tubing setting requirements as contained in Division Rule 107(d)(3) for the below-named well.


Pursuant to the authority granted me by Rule 107(d)(4), you are hereby authorized to make a tubingless completion in the following well:

Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

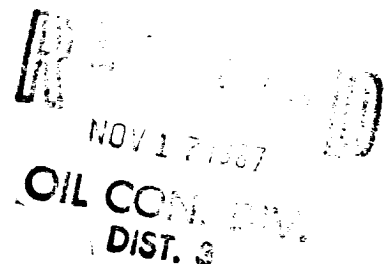
The Division reserves the right to rescind this authority in the event that waste appears to be resulting therefrom.
