Order R-3338 established pool rules for the Salt Creek Dakota Oil Pool.

Rule 2 of the referenced order requires each well to be at least 165 feet from the outer boundary of the quarter-quarter section upon which it is drilled.

The form C-102 filed for the subject well does not indicate the well to be 165 feet from the quarter-quarter section line.

Therefore, approval of the non-standard location must be approved before we can approve the well for production.
