*We have received two copies of a Federal Notice of Intention to Drill for your #3 Dick Hunt Federal well located in the SW<sub>4</sub> Section 1-30N-14W. You have indicated on the notice that the production string will be cemented at 6550 feet with 150 sacks with no indication that the production pipe will be stage-cemented across the Mesaverde Formation. Due to isolated occurrences of natural gas in the Mesaverde Formation in this area and also due to a severe corrosion problem which has developed from water encountered in the Penejee formation we are requiring that all wells drilled in this area be cemented across the Mesaverde Formation. This may be done by use of a two-stage tool at the base of the Point Lookout sandstone. Enough cement should be used to cover about 1200 feet of the section, which is the thickness of the Mesaverde Formation in this area.*
