ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on July 11, 1979,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 30th day of July, 1979, the Division
Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the
recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the
premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required
by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the
subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Dugan Production Corporation, is
the owner and operator of the following wells, all in Township
30 North, Range 14 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico:

Big Field Well No. 2 in Unit C of Section 3;
Big Field Well No. 5 in Unit P of Section 10;
Dinero Well No. 1 in Unit H of Section 13; and the
~~Molly Pitcher~~ Well No. 2 in Unit H of Section 14.

(3) That the applicant seeks authority to commingle
Conner-Fruitland and undesignated Pictured Cliffs production
within the wellbores of the above-described wells.

(4) That from the Conner-Fruitland zone, the subject
wells are or are expected to be capable of low marginal produc-
tion only.
