THE APPLICATION OF TENNECO OIL COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2642

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Tenneco Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 30, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Florance Well No. 114 located in Unit L of Section 11, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, and from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 19th day of May, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights;
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Florance Well No. 114 located in Unit L of Section 11, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, and from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVEDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
