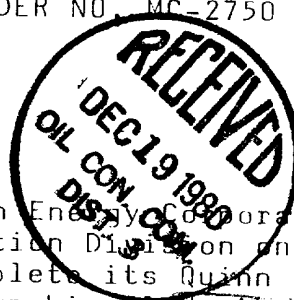


THE APPLICATION OF SUPRON
ENERGY CORPORATION FOR A
DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2750

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Supron Energy Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on November 20, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Quinn Well No. 7A located in Unit P of Section 17, Township 31 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 25th day of November, 1980, the Division Director finds:

1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
3. That waivers of objection have been received from such offsetting operators;
4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Supron Energy Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Quinn Well No. 7A located in Unit P of Section 17, Township 31 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

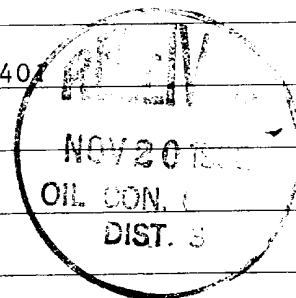

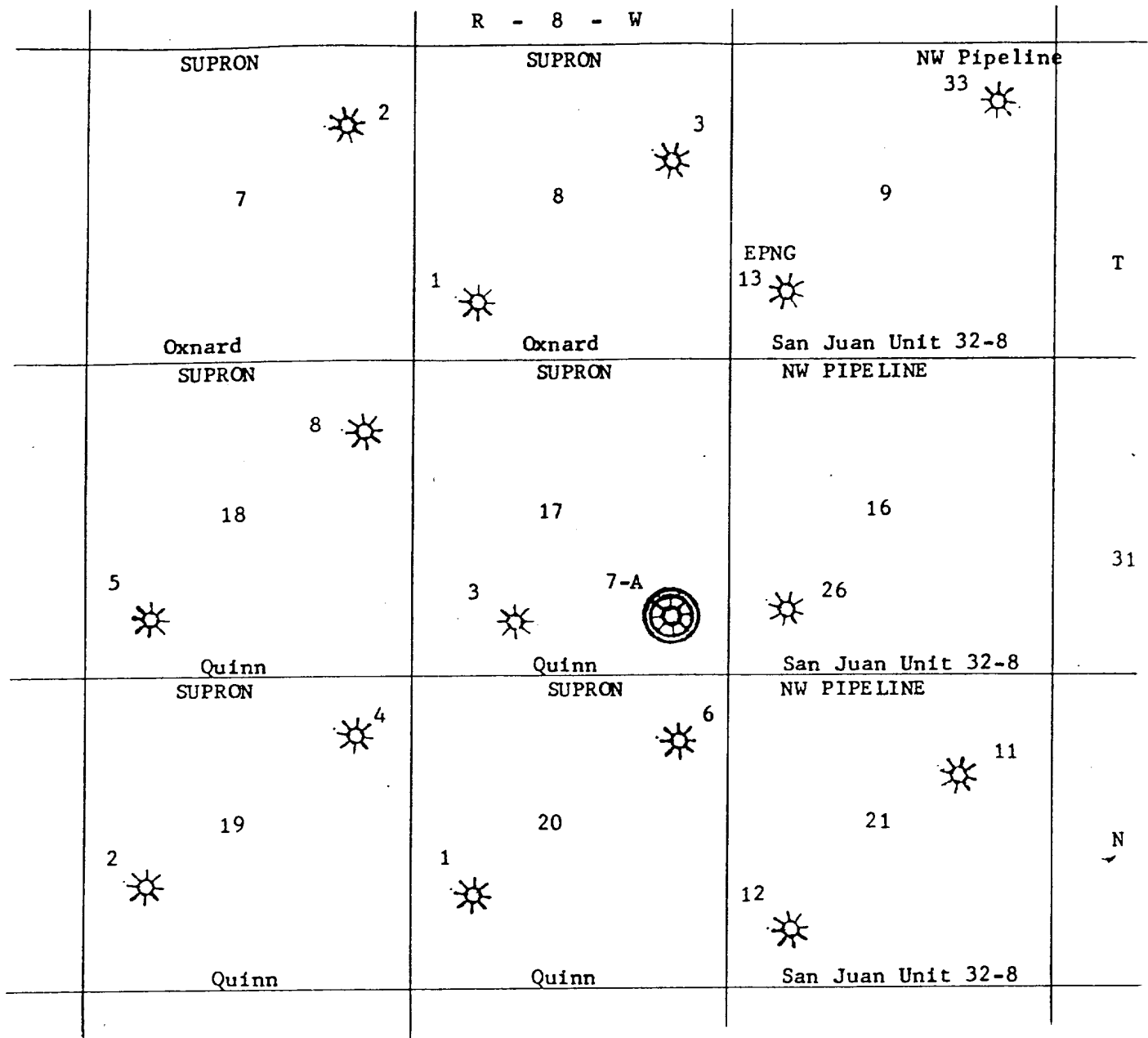
Should waivers from all offset operators not accompany an application for administrative approval, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission will hold the application for a period of twenty (20) days from date of receipt by the Commission's Santa Fe office. If, after said twenty-day period, no protest nor request for hearing is received by the Santa Fe office, the application will then be processed.

NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard perforation unit in one or more of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.

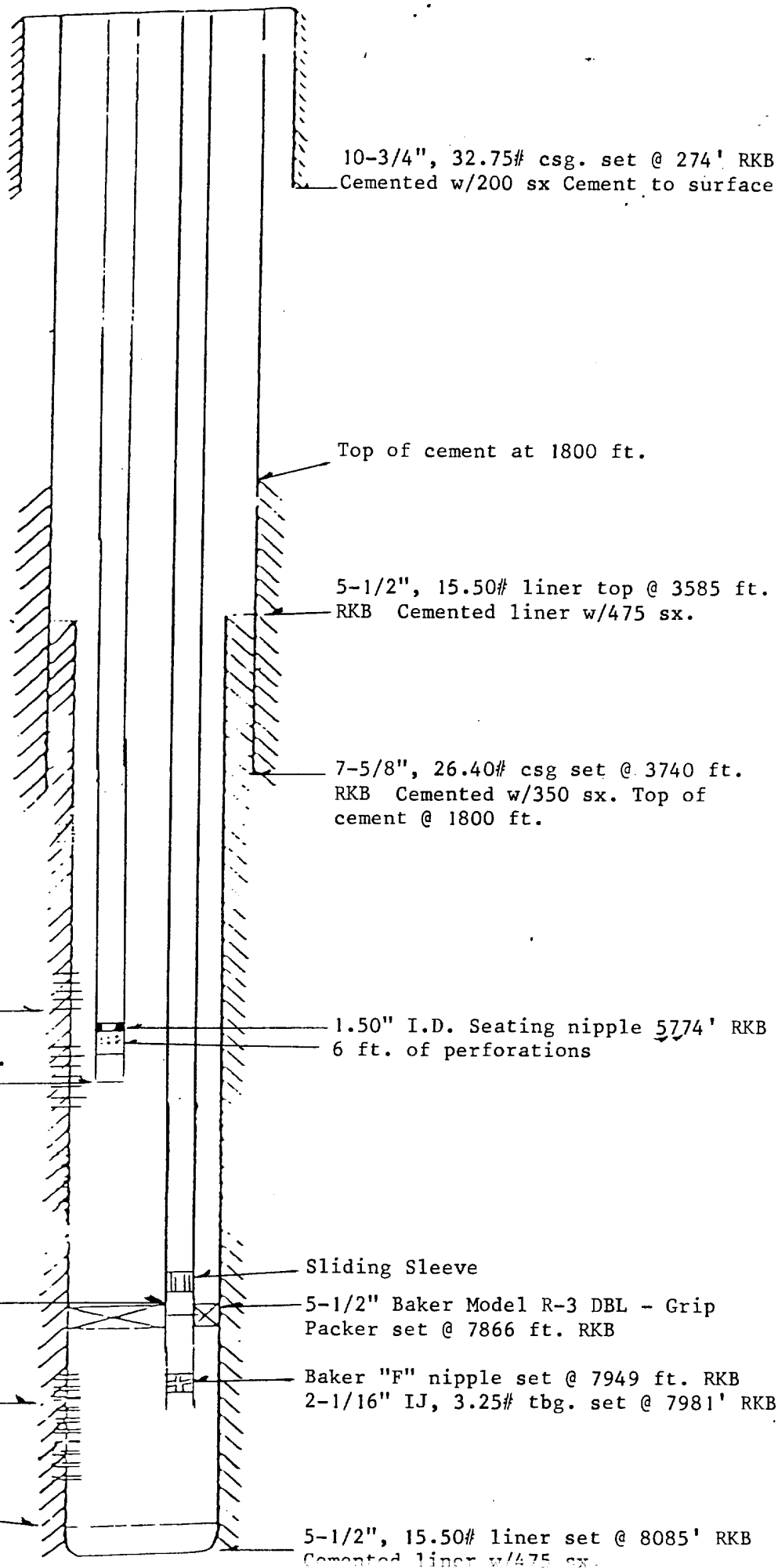


Proposed Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota Dual

Marvin Kruschke, being first dually sworn according to law upon his oath deposes and says:

That he is of lawful age and has full knowledge of the facts herein below set out.

That he is employed by Baker Packers in the capacity of
Manager and as such as its authorized agent.

That on October 7, 1980, he personally supervised the setting of
5-182" Baker Model R-3 Double-Grip Packer in Supron Energy Corporation's
(Make and Type of Packer) (Operator)

Quinn Well No. 7-A, located in Unit Letter
P, Section 17, Township 31 North, Range 8 West,
M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

That said packer was set at a subsurface depth of 7866 feet, said depth
measurement having been furnished by John Walters.

That the purpose of setting this packer was to effect a seal in the annular space between
the two strings of pipe where the packer was set so as to prevent the commingling, within the
well-bore, of fluids produced from a stratum below the packer with fluids produced from a
stratum above the packer. That this packer was properly set and that it did, when set,
effectively and absolutely seal off the annular space between the two strings of pipe where
it was set in such manner as to prevent any movement of fluids across the packer.
