- A. Approve the attached communitization agreement covering lots 1 and 2, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) sec. 25, T. 30 N., R. 9 W., N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, as to natural gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons producible from the Basin Dakota formation.

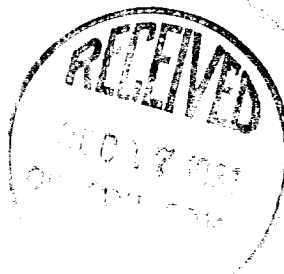
