MC-2680 DIST 3 ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on June 30, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Sunray D Well No. 2R located in Unit A of Section 21, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool. Now, on this 21st day of July, 1980, the Division Director finds: That application has been filed under the provisions (1)of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations; That satisfactory information has been provided that (2) all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and That no objections have been received within the waiting (3) period as prescribed by said rule. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste (4) nor impair correlative right. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Sunray D Well No. 2R located in Unit A of Section 21, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New MExico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing. PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A. PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
