Application for Right to Produce at an Unorthodox Well Location Federal Gas Com "E" No. 1-E, Basin Dakota Infill Well SE/4 of Section 30-T30N-R12W San Juan County, New Mexico

By this verified application submitted in triplicate, Amoco requests approval to produce gas from the Basin Dakota formation at the captioned well, a Basin Dakota infill well, at the unorthodox location of 2,020' FSL and 670' FEL of Section 30, T30N, R12W. Permissible location for a Basin Dakota infill well must be at least 790' from the outer boundary of the undrilled quarter section of the 320 acre proration unit, and at least 130' from any quarter quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary.


