Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 122 Florance, SW/4NW/4 sec. 10, T. 30 N., R. 9 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease SF-081098-A and your Sundry Notice approved May 9, 1990. This well has been approved for plugging for over a year. If the well has been plugged, you are required to submit a subsequent report of abandonment. If the well has not been plugged, you are required to submit your plans of when this well is to be plugged.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 1449, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-1449. Such request shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. seq.
