THE APPLICATION OF TOM BOLACK FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2853

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Tom Bolack made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on May 1, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Tommy Bolack Well No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 1, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Flora Vista Gallup Pool and the Basin Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 22nd day of May, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulation;
- That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been notified;
- 3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- 4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights;
- 5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tom Bolack, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete his Tommy Bolack Well No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 1, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Flora Vista Gallup Pool and the Basin Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
