Gentlemen:

A recent inspection by members of my staff showed that the following work needs to be done to bring your No. 7-E Lively well located 1840' FSL and 1100' FWL, sec. 35, T. 30 N., R. 8 W., lease No. SF-078385-A into compliance:

Areas of pad not needed for production and old reserve pit area need to be seeded with ELM Seed Mix No. 2. As stipulated in your approved AFD, drilling of the seed will be done on the contour where possible. Where slopes are too steep for contour drilling a "cyclone" hand-seeder or similar broadcast seeder will be used, using twice the recommended seed per acre. Seed will then be covered to a depth of one-half inch to three-quarter inch. The seeding shall be done between July 1 to September 1, 1986.

We should be notified by letter or Sundry Notice when the surface restoration is completed. We will schedule an inspection to check the well site after the grass has had a chance to become established.
