Gentlemen:

In response to the above-referenced correspondence regarding the venting of solution gas on our Federal #1-19, we hereby request that you grant permission to continue venting the gas.

The gas-oil ratio for the three years the well has been producing have been as follows:

1982	3075
1983	1712
1984	1531. <i>&lt; 10 MCFD</i>

As you can see the ratio is steadily decreasing. Please refer to our original application letter of July 9, 1982, and note the economics run then assumed a constant GOR of 3075 and calculated no payout. The situation in this area has changed only for the worse over the years, therefore the economics are worse. Over the last couple of years there has been no further drilling or gas gathering systems installed in the area.
