## NORTHWEST NEW MEXICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- A packer leakage test shall be commenced on each multiply completed well within seven days after across completion of the well, and annually thereafter as prescribed by the order surhorizing the multiple completion. Such tests shall also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and/or themical of fracnies treatments, and whenever remedial work has been done on a well during which the packet or the rubing have been directled. Tests shall also be taken as any time that communication at suspected or when requested by the Division.
- At least 72 hours prior to the commencement of any packer leakage test, the operator shall notally the Division in writing of the exact time the test is to be commenced, Offset operators shall also be so notified.
- The packer lexistage tex shall commence when both zones of the dual completion are shur-in for previous nabilitation. Both zones shall remain shur-in until the well-head pressure in each has nabilited, provided however, that they need not remain short-in more than seven days.
- 4. For Flow Ten No. 1, one rone of the dual completion shall be produced at the normal rate of production while the other zone remains short-in. Such next shall be continued for seven days in the case of a sall be continued for seven days in the case of an oil well. Note: if, on an initial packer leakage tent, a gas well is being flowed to the acmosphere due to the lack of a pipeline connection the flow period shall be three bours.
- 3. Following completion of Flow Test No. 1, the well shall again be shot-in, in accordance with Paragraph 3 above.
- 6. Flow Text'No. 2 shall be conducted even though no leak was indicated during Flow Text No. 1. Procedure for Flow Text No. 2 is so be the same as for Flow Text No. 1 except

that the previously produced 2000 shall remain abus-in while the 2000 which was previous ly shot in is produced.

7. Pressures for gas-rone term must be nocusared on each rone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3 hours term: innerediately prior to the beginning of each flow-period, as fifteen-minute intervals during the first hour thereof, and a hourst intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. 7-day term: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, as least one time during each flow period (at approximately the midwarpoint) and immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures make taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have periodicy shown questionable test data.

8. The results of the above-described term shall be filed in triplicate with completion of the term. Term shall be filed with the Arner Dutum Office to Oil Conservation Division on Northwest New Mexico Pitcher Leakage "10-01-78 with all deadweight premuers indicated thereon as with semperatures (gas 2000s only) and gravity and GOR (will 2000s only).
