This is a request for approval of shut in of the above-referred-to well on a long term basis.

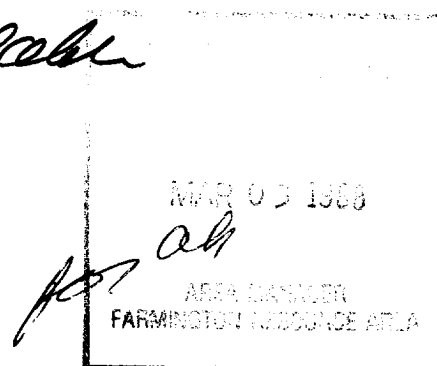
The reasons for this request are as follows:

1. The rods are parted in the well. Therefore, the well is not in a pumping condition. Due to frequent parting of rods and condition of rods, the rod string should be replaced.
2. The well cannot be repaired at this time due to:
 - a. The well is involved in the filing of Bankruptcy by Lobo Production.
 - b. There is no clear documentation as to ownership of working interest by investors in the well.
3. It is now apparent that the situation concerning ownership of working interest by investors will not be resolved in the near future.
