Plans are to bury a #2 and a #8 guage cathodic cable 12 to 18 inches in the ground from a proposed cathodic cable located in the NW1/4 SE1/4, Sec. 22, T.31 N., R.7 W. to the NEBU 214 well location, as shown on the attached map. The purpose of this undertaking is to provide cathodic protection for the NEBU 214 well casing. The cable will be routed parallel to an existing Williams Field Sevice pipeline and access road and will be 10 to 15 feet from the pipeline. No right-of-way clearing will be required and the cable will be plowed in with the use of a ripper tooth on a ditch witch. All surface disturbance will be confined to the existing 50 foot right-of-way. A ground bed will be drilled with a small truck mounted rig and will not require any blading. It will be drilled with air and will not require a water pit. This project will be 1,500. feet in length and on Bureau of Land Management lands.
