

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to attempt to pull the existing 5 1/2" liner, clean the open hole, re-run the 5 1/2" liner and return the well to production. If the liner cannot be pulled, a CIBP will be set 50' above the end of the 7" casing. A whipstock will be run in hole on 3 1/2" DP and set on top of the CIBP. A window will be milled and drilled out to original Fruitland Coal TD of 3260'. The hole will then be cleaned out and a 5 1/2" liner will be re-run and the well returned to production.
