13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to cleanout the subject well in the following manner:

MIRU. Pull the tubing. Pull the 5 1/2" liner. Clean the well to TD and run a 5 1/2" 15.5# K-55 casing liner. The liner will be pre-perforated 4 SPF across the coal intervals. Re-run the production tubing. The well will then be returned to production.

Per verbal approval by Ruben, BLM on 2-12-99 @ 3:30 p.m., the following stipulations apply:

- 1) All disturbances will be kept on the existing pad.
- 2) Pits will be fenced during workover.
- 3) Pits will be emptied & reclaimed after work is completed.
- 4) Pits must be lined with impervious material at least 8 mm thick.
- 5) Wash trees and other vegetation with fresh water when drilling/workover when completed if covered with foam or other production debris as a result of discharge from the blooie line.
