It is proposed to renew temporary abandonment of this well for another year.
The last casing integrity test was performed 9/8/94.

The Fruitland Coal completion in this well was squeezed off below a retainer prior to temporary abandonment. Re-evaluation of this and offset wells has resulted in the conclusion that the Fruitland Coal in this well should be re-entered and returned to production.

Work plans for this well call for this work to be done sometime during our 1996 work window between March and September. Therefore, it is requested to continue its temporary abandonment status until this work can be performed next year.

Reference is made to your well No. 15 FC Federal Com, located 1875' FSL & 965' FWL Sec. 15, T. 30 N., R. 11 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, Lease NMNM-019410. The subject well has been approved for temporary abandonment until October 24, 1995 to evaluate. To date, we have not received your plans for the above-mentioned well.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such requests, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the orders unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
