Dear Mr. Hawkins:

Reference is made to your application dated November 7, 1991 for a non-standard gas well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 306 to be located 1190 feet from the North line and 450 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 26, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin Dakota Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 26 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin Dakota Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
