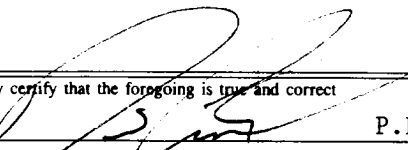
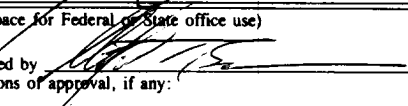
A GAS TRANSMISSION LINE IS PROPOSED TO BE LAID ALONGSIDE THE EL PASO NATURAL GAS PIPELINE. THE APPROXIMATE LENGTH WILL BE 4,200' OF 3.0" SDR-7 THERMOPLASTIC PIPE. THE SDR-7 PIPE HAS A MAXIMUM WORKING PRESSURE OF 260 PSI AT 73.4° F. WE INTEND TO BE OPERATING THE LINE AT +50 PSI. ATTACHED IS A SECTION PLAT SHOWING THE COURSE OF THE PIPELINE.

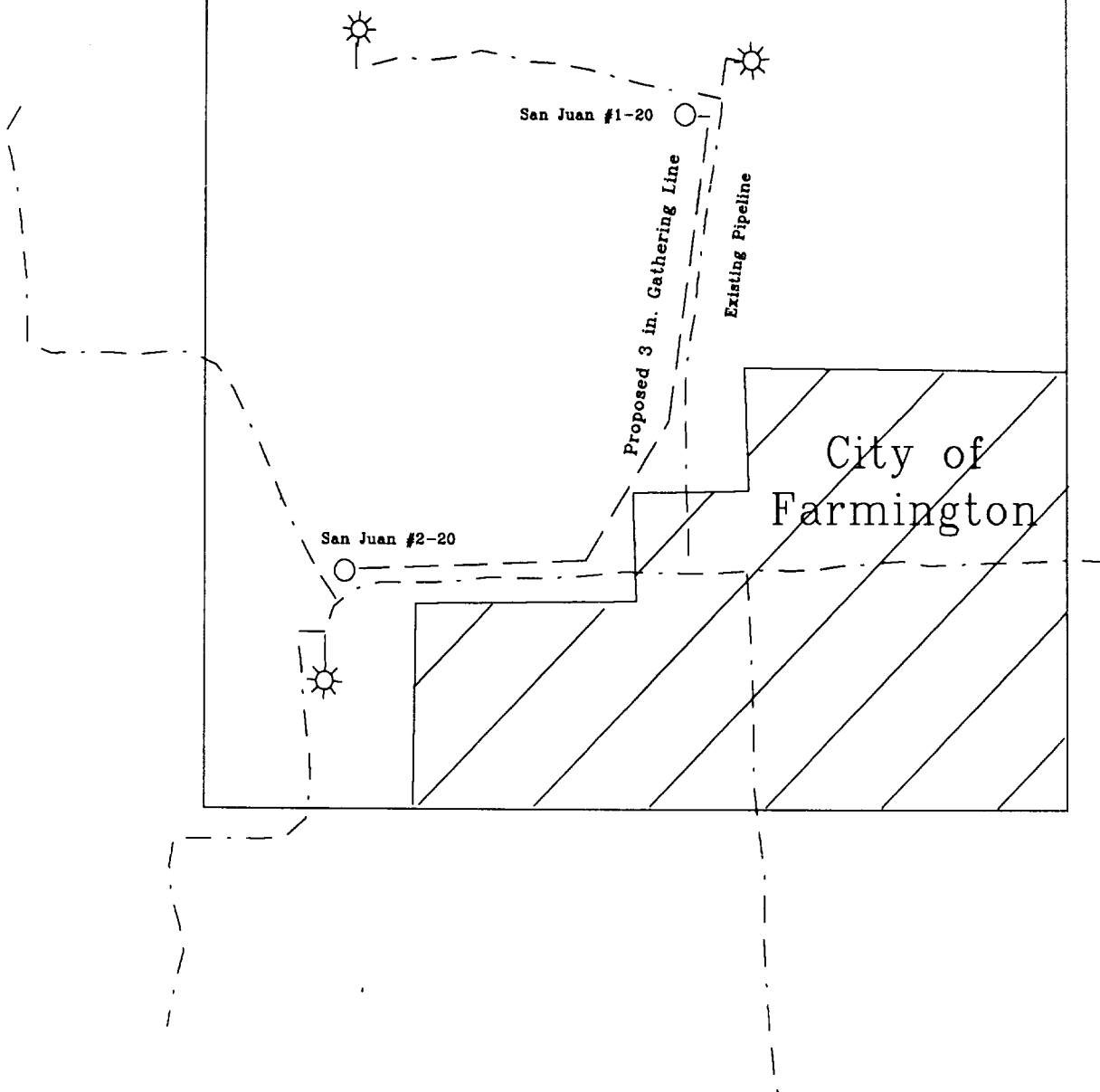
