## Dear Frank:

Northwest Pipeline Corporation is requesting temporary approval of the C-104 for the subject well pending completion of the packer leakage test. In an effort to conserve natural gas, we propose testing the permanent production packer while producing the lower zone down the pipeline. The test will be conducted immediately following first delivery of the lower zone as follows:

- 1. Both formations will be shut in for at least three (3) days.
- 2. The lower zone will be first delivered to the pipeline and the SITP and SICP for the upper zone will be monitored for two (2) days.
- 3. After the lower zone has produced for two (2) days, the upper zone will be first delivered.

The results of the packer test will be submitted to the NMOCD on an approved form as soon as the test is complete.
