13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work. Due to the shape and location of the subject well's pad, an increase buffer is needed on the east and south sides of the well pad. Plans are to clear up to 50' in depth for a length of 75' - 100' north of the southeast corner and 75' - 100' west from the southeast corner. Verbal approval was given by Ruben Sanchez, BLM - surface department with the following conditions of approval:

1. If have to clear more than the area indicated above, verbal approval will have to be received. Call BLM and have Ruben paged.
2. Wood and vegetation will be stockpiled out of the way and after the well is drilled and completed this buffer zone will have to be reseeded and the original vegetation be distributed back on the cleared area for erosion protection. The area to be reseeded needs to be worked over to insure the seeds are incorporated into the soil (by hand if need be).
3. Make sure no access to the disturbed area is to be left exposed. Berm as needed.
4. Since this wood and vegetation are the only way to eliminate erosion that this buffer zone will cause, call the BLM if there is a problem with woodhaulers taking the wood before reseeded and restoration can take place.
