Dear Mr. Ryan:

Reference is made to your application dated March 23, 1999 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for Cross Timbers Oil Company's proposed Federal Gas Com. "H" Well No. 2 (API No. 30-045-29705) to be drilled 2045 feet from the North line and 1685 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lots 1 and 2, the NE/4, and the E/2 NW/4 (N/2 equivalent) of Section 31 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 318.74-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.
