Reference is made to your application submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on July 16, 1999 for an exception to the well location requirements provided within the *'Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool,'* as promulgated by Division Order No. R-10987, as amended. Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10, and 11 and the NW/4 NE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of Section 25, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico is to be dedicated to the proposed well in order to form a standard 320.00-acre, more or less, stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

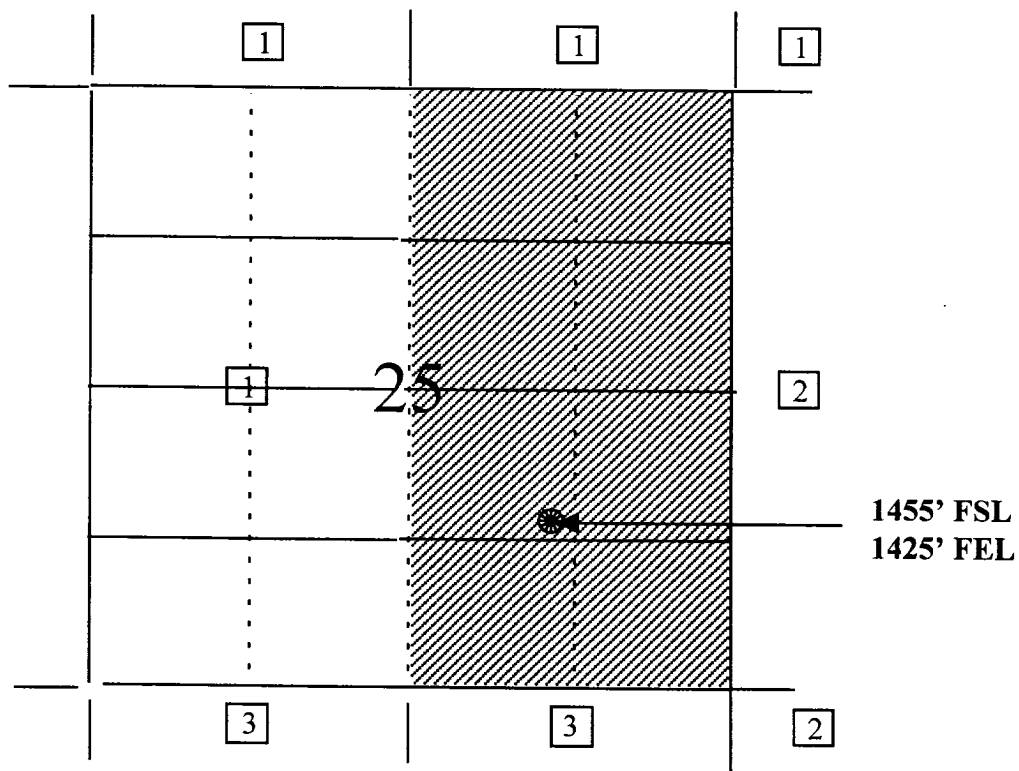
