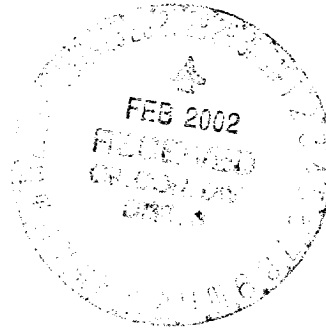

The above referenced well is a Mesaverde/Dakota commingle. Attached is a copy of the allocation for the commingling of the subject well completed on May 15, 2001. DHC-398az was issued for this well.

Gas: Mesa Verde 72%
Dakota 28%

Oil: Mesa Verde 72%
Dakota 28%

These allocations are based on isolated flow tests from the Mesa Verde and Dakota during completion operations. Oil was not present during flow test operations. For that reason, oil percentages are based upon gas allocation and are provided in the event this wellbore begins producing oil at some point in the future. PRODUCTION ALLOCATION FORMULA USING WELL TEST INFORMATION

Seymour #11
(Mesaverde/Dakota) Commingle
Unit J, 25-T31N-R9W
San Juan County, New Mexico

Allocation Formula Method:

Separator test from Mesaverde = 193 MCFD & 0 BO

Separator test from Dakota = 76 MCFD & 0 BO

GAS:

$$\frac{(MV) 193 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV/ DK) 269 \text{ MCFD}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 72\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 76 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV/DK) 269 \text{ MCFD}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 28\%}$$

OIL:

$$\frac{(MV) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV/ DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 72\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 0 \text{ BO}}{(MV/ DK) 0 \text{ BO}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 28\%}$$
