Cementing:

7" surface casing - cement with 46 sx Class B w/3% calcium chloride, 0.25 pps Cello-flake (54 cu.ft. of slurry, 200% excess to circulate to surface). WOC 8 hrs. Test casing to 600 psi for 30 minutes.

4 1/2" production casing - Lead w/205 sx Premium Lite cement w/3% calcium chloride, 1/4 pps flocele, 5 pps LCM-1, 0.4% FL-52, and 0.4% SMS. Tail w/90 sx Type III cement w/1% calcium chloride, 1/4 pps flocele, and 0.2% FL-52 (561 cu.ft. of slurry, 125% excess to circulate to surface.)
