Mesa Verde to be fractured thru perfs using approx 150,000 gals water. Clean out to total depth, set tubing and complete well.

The SW/4, NW/4SE/4, Lots 6, 7, & 8, of Section 4 and Lot 5 of Section 5, containing 323.15 acres, is dedicated to this well.

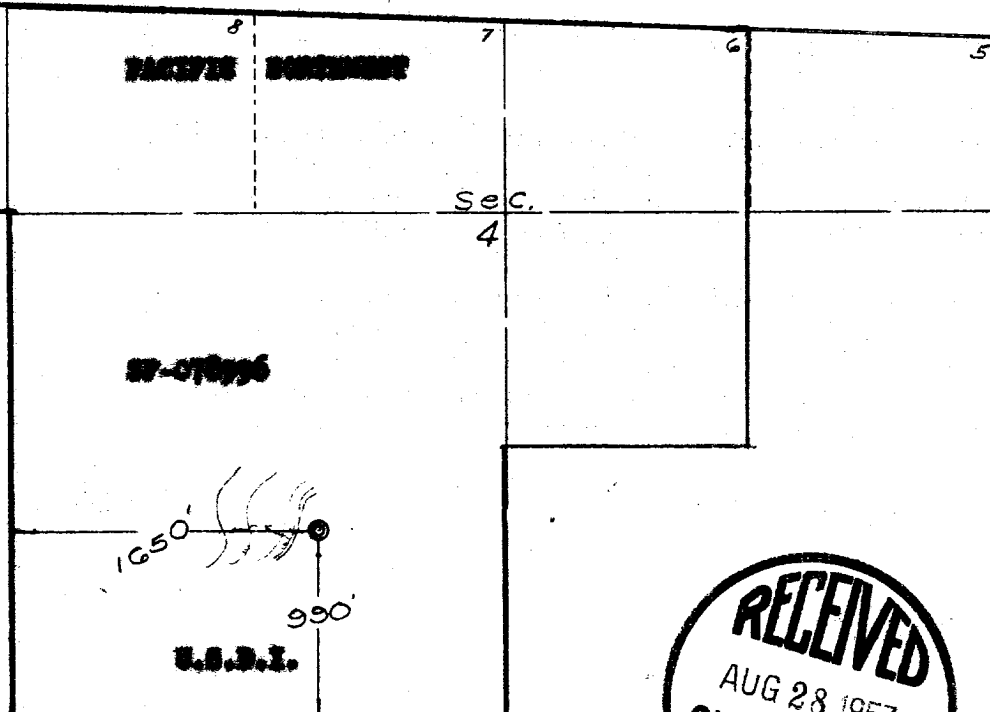
