Re: Packer Leakage Test on the El Paso Natural  
Gas Company well, Sellers # 3-A, SW 30-30-10,  
San Juan County, New Mexico.

Dear Mr. Arnold:

This well was dually completed in the Pictured Cliff and Mesa Verde zones. A packer was set at 2527 feet. The Mesa Verde zone was tested September 25, 1956 with the following results obtained:

SIPC 652 (shut-in 15 days)  
SIPT 683

The tubing was opened at 10:13 A.M. through a 3/4" choke and was left open for three hours.
