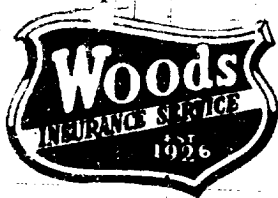

I have just received a copy of your letter dated November 12, 1963 advising Mr. Dave Martin of Bloomfield, New Mexico that "The Oil Conservation Commission hereby approves cancellation of the above captioned plugging bond."

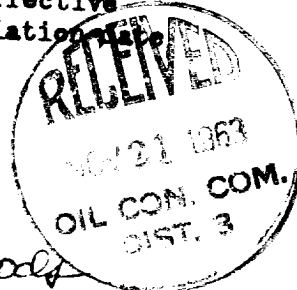
I am enclosing herewith a copy of my letter to the Oil Conservation Commission dated July 24th. As you can see from this letter there is a question in our minds as to whether or not Mr. Martin's bond was ever needed. It seems as though the El-Mi-Ri Oil Company had a blanket bond which covered these particular wells up until the date that Mr. Woodrow Stiles of Aztec, New Mexico filed his \$10,000.00 blanket drilling bond.

If such is the case, that is if Mr. Martin's bond in fact did never guarantee anything, the bonding company is agreeable to cancelling his bond back to June 21, 1961. Before the bonding company can do this it will be necessary for them to have a letter so stating. With the letter which you have mailed to Mr. Dave Martin dated November 12th the bonding company could do no more than cancel the bond effective November 12th. Will you please advise us as to what cancellation stamp we should use on Mr. Martin's Bond.

Gentlemen:

Effective June 21, 1961 we wrote a \$10,000.00 Blanket Drilling Bond in favor of the State of New Mexico for Dave Martin of Bloomfield, New Mexico. Recently Mr. Martin has made an arrangement to name Woodrow Stiles of Aztec who also has a \$10,000.00 Blanket Drilling Bond to take over the operation of his well or wells. When Mr. Martin asked me to release his bond I told him that it would be up to the Oil Conservation Commission of the State to do this.

When talking to Mr. Emery Arnold of the Aztec office Mr. Arnold told me that his records indicate that these wells were never properly assigned or transferred from the El-Mi-Ri Oil Company to Mr. Martin. His records show that Mr. Martin's bond in effect does not cover anything since the transfer was never approved.

Will you therefore please give us a release of Mr. Martin's Bond effective June 1961.

You have in your \$10,000 blanket plugging bond file a bond made out to Dave Martin. This bond was written by the Woods Insurance Service 115 East Main, Farmington, New Mexico. Mr. Martin posted this bond as it has been his intention to take over ownership of 3 Farmington Sandstone oil wells. However these wells were never transferred to Mr. Martin and as a result no wells have ever been covered by the bond.
