DETAILS OF WORK

Original TD 8095'. Original PBD 7995'. On 6/3/58, pulled 2-3/8" tubing. Hole caved back to 7900'. Cleaned out to TD and on 6/6/58, ran 12 Jts 4" 16.60# flush joint line pipe as liner - 328' set at 7961' and hung at 7633' with Beach-Rose plain hanger. Cemented with 125 sac' 4 1/2 gal cement with 1 lb medium Tuf Plug per sack. Tested casing with 1000 PSI for 30 minutes. Held OK. Cement plug back depth: 7950'.
