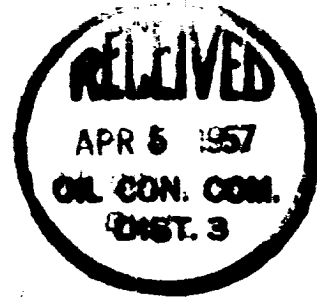

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 51-29 to be located 500 feet from the South line and 2065 feet from the West line and in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 29, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, Blanco Mesaverde Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the Southwest quarter of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only affected offset operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Section 1 (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, as set forth in Order R-110 as amended by Order R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Section 1 (c) of Order R-110 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.

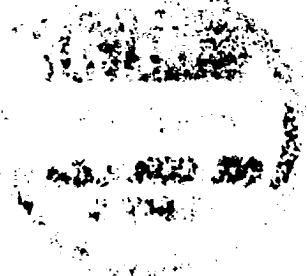
