APPLICATION OF ANDERSON-PRICHARD OIL CORPORATION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF RULE 1 (B) OF ORDER NO. R-128-D OF A 263.25 ACRE NON-STANDARD GAS PRORATION UNIT IN THE BLANCO-MESAVERDE POOL, CONSISTING OF THE N/2 OF SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.



APPLICATION

Comes now the applicant and in support of its Application, states:

- 1. It is the operator of the Johnston-Federal No. 7 well located 990 feet from the North Line and 990 feet from the East Line of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- 2. The Johnston-Federal No. 7 well was completed as a gas well in the Mesaverde Formation in April of 1953 and presently has the E/2 of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West attributed to it for gas allowable purposes.
- 3. In applicant's opinion, the proposed non-standard gas proration unit meets the requirements of Rule 1 (b) of Order No. R-128-D for the following reasons:
 - (a) The unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections and/or lots;
 - (b) The unit lies wholly within a single governmental section;
 - (c) The entire unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 4. Attached to this Application and identified as Exhibit "A" is a plat showing the acreage in the proposed unit, the location of the well and the ownership of the offset tracts.
- 5. Attached to this Application and identified as Exhibit "B" is an Affidavit stating that all operators owning interests in the section in which the proposed non-standard proration unit is located and all operators owning interests in acreage offsetting the proposed non-standard gas proration unit have been mailed a copy of this Application by registered mail.

WHEREFORE, applicant respectfully requests administrative approval of this non-standard gas proration unit pursuant to Rule 1 (b) of Order R-128-D.
