Dear Sir:

Pursuant to your letter of February 18, 1982, requesting exception to Rule 705-A for fifty-seven (57) wells as listed on Table I, the Oil Conservation Division hereby denies both of your requests. You are hereby requested to take prompt action as outlined in the September 30, 1981, Memorandum. (Copy enclosed).

The Oil Conservation Division will not grant an exception to Rule 705-A if a well will not be placed in service within 6 months of the request. For future reference, supportive data for exception to Rule 705-A should include:

1. Proof of mechanical integrity, such as bradenhead tests, tracer logs, or other supportive tests or data.
2. All related OCD Division Order Numbers or Case Hearing Numbers.
3. A schematic of the present injection well including cement tops and quantities thereof.
4. Date each well was shut-in.
