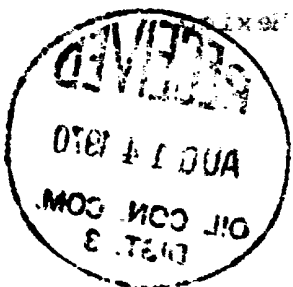

WELL NO. 1 LOCATED 660 FEET FROM THE NORTH LINE AND 1380 FEET FROM THE WEST LINE, AND SARGENT WELL NO. 1 LOCATED 1445 FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE AND 925 FEET FROM THE WEST LINE.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on August 5, 1970, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Utz.

NOW, on this 12th day of August, 1970, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the subject wells have been plugged and abandoned to the satisfaction of the Commission.

(3) That the subject case should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That Case No. 4397 is hereby dismissed.
