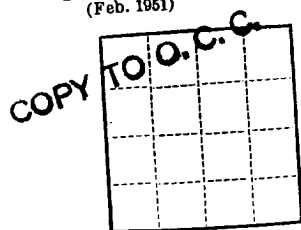

DETAILS OF WORK

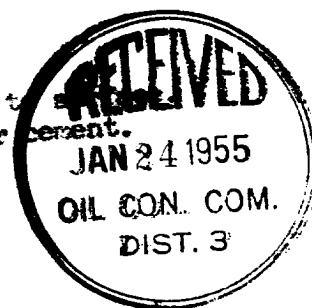

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools through the Mesa Verde drilling the pay section with gas circulation, and to sand-oil the Cliff House and Point Lookout formations. Total depth 5195'.

Casing program:

3 5/8" at 170' with 125 sacks regular cement circulated to cement.
7" at 4900' with 250 sacks Pozmix and 250 sacks regular cement.

The 1/2 of Section 31 is dedicated to this well.
