Formation broke down 1900# back to 1500#. Sand fraced perforations with 5000 gallons crude oil and 5000# 10/20 sand. Formation broke down at 1500#. Average treating pressure 1500#, final treating pressure 1800#, average injection rate 27 BPM. Job complete 7:30 P.M., 10-20-58.
