2. Cemented first stage with 350 cu. ft. 1-1 Diarix with 1/2 gal. Plug down at 1:15 A.M. 4/1/61.
3. Ran temperature survey on first stage. Top of cement at 5620.
4. Cemented second stage thru D.V. tool using 540 cu. ft. 40% Diarix "D" with 2 1/2 c.c. Plug down at 11:35 A.M. 4/1/61.
5. Ran temperature survey on second stage cement. Top at 3175'
