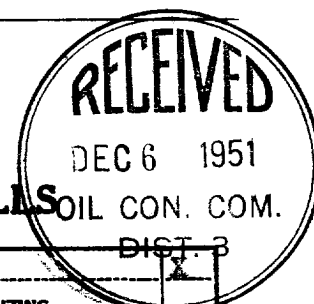

DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded at 6:00 AM on December 1, 1951.
Drilled 13 3/8" Rotary hole to 222 feet.
Ran 215.05 feet of 10 3/4" OD, 32.75% surface casing.
Cemented same and circulated out with 120 sacks cement.
Plug down at 2:30 AM, December 2, 1951.
Drilled cement out down to plug, closed runs, pressured up to 500# and held same for thirty minutes.
