

## DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled to 1285' T.D. Ran 39 joints 5-1/2" O.D. 11.7 J-55 casing = 1277.83'.  
Set at 1285.15' and cemented with 150 sacks regular Pozmix. Plug down 2:04  
A.M., 9-15-58. Had good returns while cementing. Ran 7 centralizers. W.O.C.  
13 hours, released surface pressure to run Temperature Survey. Top of cement  
450'. W.O.C. to 2:00 A.M., 9-16-58. Hung casing on slips with 21,000#.  
Nipped up tubing head. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. OK
